

Packing List

Please realize that your children will be in the great outdoors! They need to dress for success, not to impress. If they bring expensive clothes, they will probably get ruined. Bring comfortable clothes that you wouldn't mind getting soiled or lost. Campers wearing inappropriate outfits will be asked to change.

Suggested Packing List (1 Week) Please label everything you send to camp. Many campers arrive with new items at camp and may not remember what belongs to them at the end of the week. Also include a list of items they brought and a laundry bag to help your child at the end of the week.
